AHAA's 15th Anniversary Events

The **American Healing Arts Alliance Inc.** will be celebrating fifteen years since our founding as a non-profit organization in June of 1996. We began our alliance of healing arts instructors, practitioners and supportive individuals with the goal of providing healing arts educational programs to the health conscious general public.

A Brief History

As a 501(c)3 educational organization we expanded to include networking opportunities for professionals and informative publications widely distributed as a free resource guide to the community. The AHAA! Magazine included articles, monthly educational events, and a

comprehensive professional directory. For those new to our history and evolution we were founded by healing arts practitioner and educator Alice Yeager who invited others in the healing arts field to join together to create an alliance of professionals dedicated to serving the community.

As AHAA grew our programs expanded to include peacebuilding projects inspired by inner guidance received by Alice as a highly skilled professional intuitive. These included the Inner Peace Treaty™ global journaling project and the Peace Pulse™ subtle energy healing practice as part of a comprehensive healing and creative arts educational program called Peace Nouvella™.

The newest addition to AHAA's Peace Nouvella™ educational programs is the Peace Nouvella Players™ ensemble of creative and performing artists dedicated to presenting inspiring healing arts themed educational programs within an entertaining format. These presentations are designed to bring our programs to a larger audience including schools, conferences and community events.
