Integrative Medicine Health Care Conference

An invitation only integrative medicine healthcare conference took place in October, which was attended by **AHAA President Alice Yeager** and AHAA members Susan Ruck and Fred Hawker. It included a special videotaped dialogue between Dr.'s Andrew Weil, one of the pioneers of integrative medicine in the United States, and Dr. Michael Dixon, Chairman of the National Health Service Alliance, from the United Kingdom. The event was held in Washington, DC at the Grand Hyatt Washington Hotel on Saturday, October 9, 2010.

The goal of the conference was to bring together in dialogue Dr. Weil and Dr. Dixon as noted health professionals in the field of integrative medicine to discuss the present state and future of integrative health care in the U.S. and U.K.

Dr. Weil and Dr. Dixon shared about their efforts to bring awareness of integrative health practices into a mainstream medical model. Their dialogue included a question and answer format with the audience about their professional work and their own evolution as now prominent physicians in the field of integrative healthcare. They also spoke about ways they have incorporated the use of subtle energy medicine including the practice of johrei subtle energy healing into their work as part of an integrative medical teaching model and a healthy lifestyle.

The event was sponsored, by the **Mokichi Okada Foundation of America** (MOFA) with representatives from Japan, the United States and United Kingdom in attendance.
